Library Rules

- Library Borrower's Ticket (BT) is not transferable. B.T. is to be used only by the person to whom it is issued. A borrower is not entitled to lend books & held responsible for misuse of any B.T. issued to them. Borrower's ticket should be looked after carefully and loss of the ticket must be reported at the counter in writing without delay. Duplicate cards shall be issued only at the librarian's discretion.
- Entry to library is prohibited without BT/ID card. In case of the loss of BT new ticket shall be issued on payment as per library rule.
- Loss or damage of issued book shall be reported immediately at the counter in writing.
- Books and library material must be handled with care, as a responsible member. Please help us in maintaining library material in good condition. Check the condition of the book before issue, you may be held responsible for any damage.
- All library material should be issued from the issue counter.
- Material for reading in the library shall be issued against the B.T. Please collect your B.T. before leaving the library. Library material issued for current reading against the card shall not to be taken out of the library.
- Fine is levied at Rs. 2/- per day per book after the due date. If any student fails to return the book in time, In the event of a book being lost, damaged or mutilated, the member shall either replace it or pay the cost of the book.



- If any member desires that the lost or mutilated book should be procured by the librarian, present cost of the book shall be deposited in the account section. If the book is rare or out of print, he/she will have to get photocopied or to pay such compensation as the librarian/Principal may think proper. If the book belongs to a set or series & is not separately available then the whole set or series should be replaced.
- In case of loss of B.T./token fine of RS.100/- shall be charged.
- Any member can be asked to return a book immediately without assigning any reason, if the library requires the book.
- Deposit all your personal belongings at the Property counter. You can carry any writing material and small wallet. No cash valuable or calculator is to be left at the counter. The library will not be responsible for any loss or damage to your property.
- The library is a place for individual study. Readers are requested to co-operate, and keep the library a quiet and peaceful place. Silence is essential.
- The librarian may temporarily suspend or permanently withdraw membership if a member is found disobeying the rules and regulations of the library.
